



Wellington-Guelph Health and Housing Community Planning Table Key Messages

The following are the Key Messages from the Wellington-Guelph Health and Housing Community Planning Table (HHCPT) meeting that was held on September 23, 2025. Please share these key messages broadly with interested partners and stakeholders.

1. The Lived Experience Advisory Group (LEAG) continues to play a vital role in the development of a Health and Housing Community Plan. The Planning Table (PT) will address the recommendations presented by the LEAG regarding improved collaboration between the two groups, detailing the specific actions PT members will commit to as they move forward.
2. To advance the priorities identified by the Provision of Basic Needs Sub-Working Group, three distinct teams will take the lead on implementing its focus areas. The Poverty Task Force will oversee efforts related to the provision of basic needs. A dedicated smaller group will focus on implementing the recommendations for daytime programming in Guelph while coordinated outreach and unsheltered homelessness check-ins will be managed jointly by the Social Services Department and the Ontario Health Team (OHT).
3. A smaller group from the Health and Housing Planning Table is developing a strategy to advocate for additional funding to upper levels of government by preparing an advocacy letter and briefing note, incorporating a joint health and housing perspective.
