



## **Wellington-Guelph Health and Housing Community Planning Table Key Messages**

**The following are the Key Messages from the Wellington-Guelph Health and Housing Community Planning Table (HHCPT) meeting that was held on December 11, 2025. Please share these key messages broadly with interested partners and stakeholders.**

1. A draft of the Health and Housing Community Plan will be available in December for review, and revision with the Lived Experience Advisory Group (LEAG) will take place in the new year before being finalized in April 2026.
2. Members of the LEAG and Planning Table shared a meal together ahead of the holidays. Planning Table members are committed to building relationships and working alongside the LEAG and are signing up to participate in the LEAG meetings, scheduled for 2026. Future collaboration efforts include reviewing the draft Health and Housing Community Plan and working alongside members of the Planning Table for successful implementation of the plan.
3. Now that the OHT's Verification Process has been completed, Indigenous engagement efforts and work related to truth and reconciliation are underway. The GW OHT is organizing Indigenous engagement efforts, including sharing circles to guide culturally appropriate primary care in Guelph-Wellington, as well as the Health and Housing needs of the Indigenous community. The first learning circle was held in December with local service providers, leaders, and Indigenous community members.
4. The Planning Table discussed the impact that a cut in the Rent Supplement program would have on the community, as a result of the 2026 Social Services Budget being defeated. PT members will pull together a crisis response/contingency planning meeting with service partners.
5. Members of the Planning table will strike a smaller working group to discuss opportunities for collaboration for the Build Canada Homes Funding Application. Updates will be shared and reported back to the Planning Table.
