



## **Wellington-Guelph Health and Housing Community Planning Table Key Messages**

**The following are the Key Messages from the Wellington-Guelph Health and Housing Community Planning Table (HHCPT) meeting that was held on February 24, 2026. Please share these key messages broadly with interested partners and stakeholders.**

1. Indigenous Sharing Circles were held in the County and City to guide culturally appropriate primary care in Guelph-Wellington, as well as the Health and Housing needs of the Indigenous community. The recommendations from these Sharing Circles will be shared back with the Planning Table and LEAG in March.
2. The scattered site supportive housing component of the HART Hub is now being operationalized. 150 Community Housing units in Wellington-Guelph will receive additional wrap-around supports by Stonehenge Therapeutic Community. [Recruitment](#) for these positions is now ongoing in Guelph and Wellington County.
3. The Planning Table received recommendations for a Coordinated Outreach Strategy, which was prepared by OrgCode Consulting Inc. Partners will next prioritize the recommendations and develop a plan to support the strategy to use existing resources to coordinate health and housing outreach services across Wellington-Guelph.
4. The Planning Table formally adopted a Housing First approach to guide planning and delivery of health and housing integration in Wellington-Guelph.
