



Wellington-Guelph Health and Housing Community Planning Table Key Messages

The following are the Key Messages from the Wellington-Guelph Health and Housing Community Planning Table (HHCPT) meeting that was held on March 24, 2026. Please share these key messages broadly with interested partners and stakeholders.

1. The development of an Indigenous-led Advisory Circle for Wellington-Guelph is underway, supported by Indigenous Community Members and Heart Work Consulting. Proposed membership and function of the group will come back to the Planning Table in April.
2. The Planning Table formally endorsed the definition and principles of Housing First to guide the planning and delivery of health and housing integration for Wellington-Guelph.
3. Partners are developing a plan to support the strategy to use existing resources to coordinate health and housing outreach services across Wellington-Guelph based on the Coordinated Outreach Strategy and recommendations received in February.
