



## **Wellington-Guelph Health and Housing Community Planning Table Key Messages**

**The following are the Key Messages from the Wellington-Guelph Health and Housing Community Planning Table (HHCPT) meeting that was held on June 23, 2026. Please share these key messages broadly with interested partners and stakeholders.**

1. The WG HART Hub has been operating for over a year (since April 2025). The first year focused on supporting people transition after the closure of Consumption and Treatment Services (CTS). This year's focus is on optimizing current services and improving referral pathways, as well as introducing withdrawal management beds.
2. Applications for the 150 HART Hub Scattered-site Supportive Housing units (partnership with County of Wellington Housing Services) are currently being accepted.
3. The County of Wellington's Housing Services Division is advancing a community submission for the Build Canada Homes funding. Interested parties should contact Dave Purdy, Director of Housing Services at [davep@wellington.ca](mailto:davep@wellington.ca).
4. Three Health and Housing projects are underway:
  - Integrated Health and Housing Coordinated Outreach
  - Implementation of a 'Housing First model of Care' in W-G
  - Daytime Services in W-G
